The State of North Carolina provides a residence for the President of the University and for the chancellor of each of the sixteen constituent universities to facilitate their conduct of official business. In the event an official residence is provided for the Chancellor of the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics, it is the expectation of the Board of Trustees that the Chancellor shall occupy the official residence and regularly use the official residence for School business and functions. The Chancellor shall be required to live in the official residence as a condition of employment, except in the case where such a requirement would present a serious hardship; in any such case the Chancellor must obtain approval from the Board of Governors, except that such approval will not be necessary if the residence is being vacated temporarily while repairs or renovations are being made.
