1. POLICY

The UNC Board of Governors policy established minimum criteria for constituent institutions for minor operations or small routine facilities projects at or below which no filing of environmental documents will be required. This NCSSM policy implements UNC Board of Governors Policy 1300.3[R], Regulations on Developing Minimum Environmental Criteria Under the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act.

2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Board of Governors policy identified minimum criteria for the following types of projects at or below which no environmental documents are required to be filed: 1) major or non-routine activities (including work on structures listed in the National Register of Historic Places), and 2) non-major activity.

Chancellors of the constituent institutions are responsible for the implementation of this policy for their individual campuses. Each Chancellor, or his designee, shall interpret the provisions of the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act (NCEPA) to ensure compliance.

3. PROCEDURES

NCSSM follows the rules and regulations of the Board of Governors policy, NCEPA, and the State Historic Preservation Office. NCSSM is in the Durham Historical District, and the campus is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Chancellor has delegated this function to the Vice Chancellor for Finance and Operations who is also the Capital Projects Coordinator for the campus.
